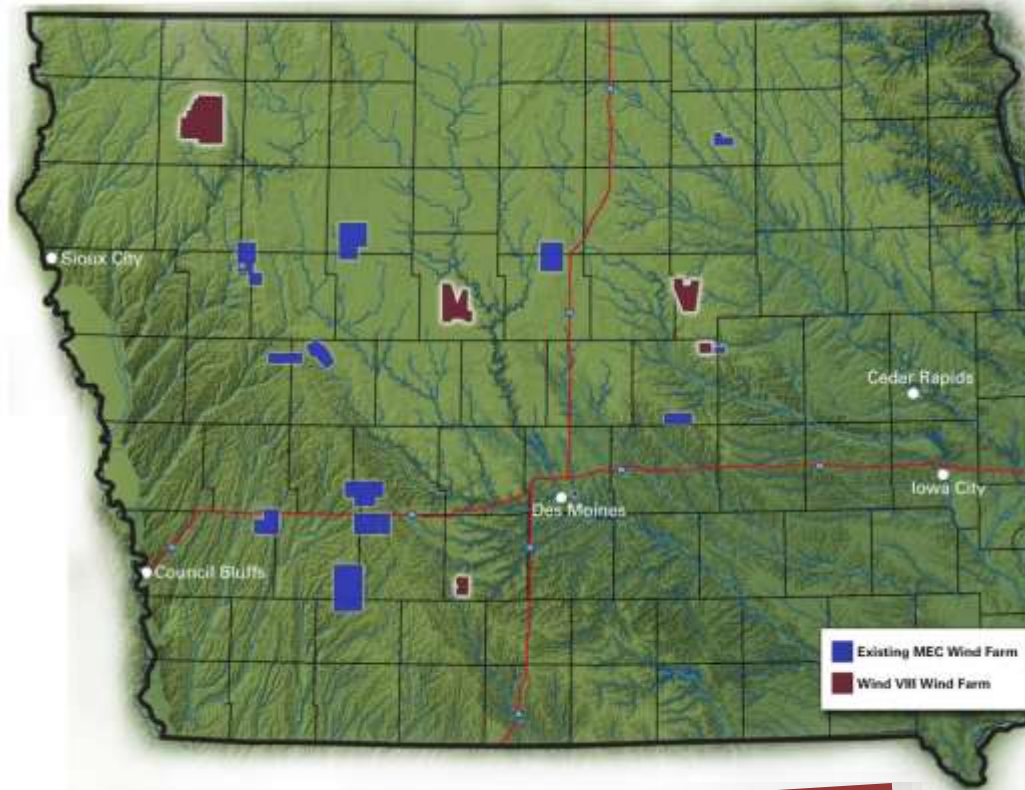

Wind Program Overview

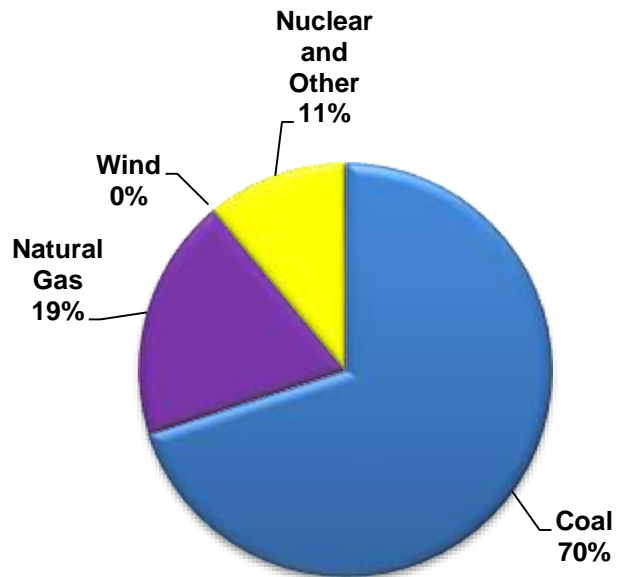

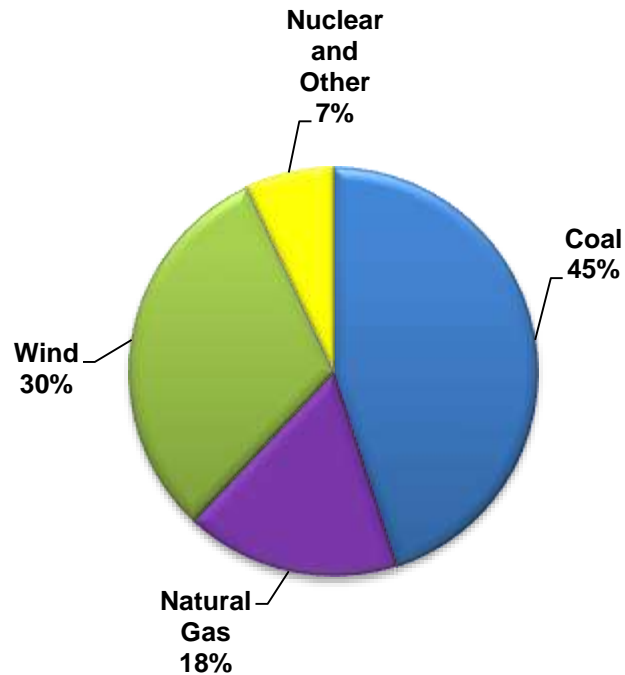

Generating Capacity by Fuel Type

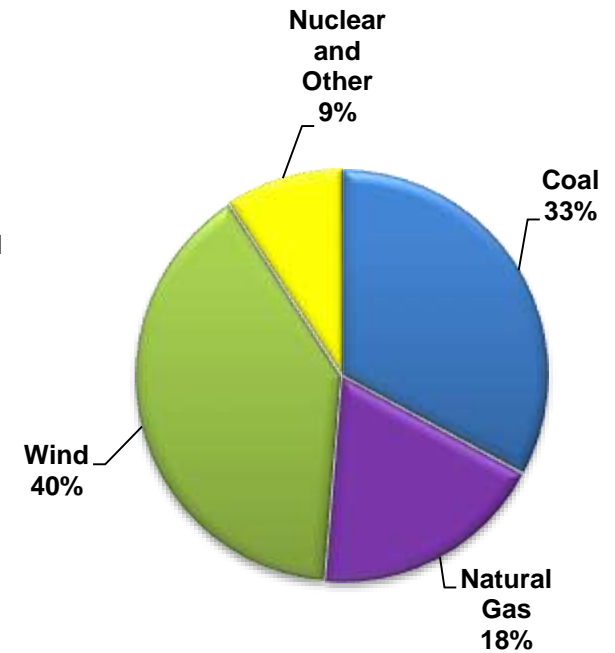
Dec. 31, 2000



Dec. 31, 2012



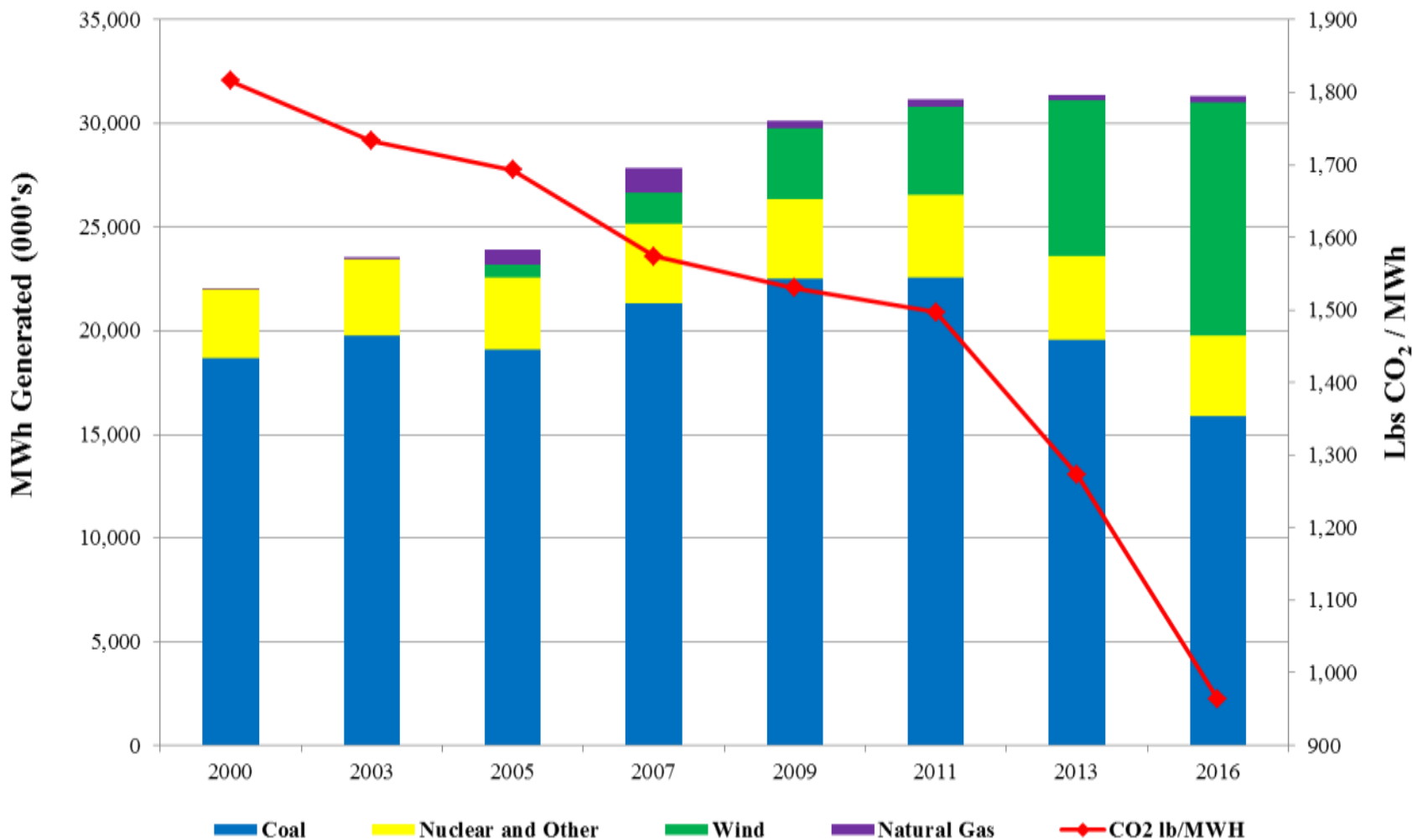
